- 2. **Interview with the Vampire (1994)** Moody, sensual, and elegantly dark.
- 3. **Only Lovers Left Alive (2013)** Slow, stylish, modern vampire romance with an indie vibe.
- 4. Let the Right One In (2008, Swedish) Haunting, atmospheric, and beautifully shot.

Witches & Dark Magic

- 5. **The Witch (2015)** Deeply unsettling, historically grounded horror with stark cinematography.
- 6. **The Love Witch (2016)** Retro, 60s/70s aesthetic with empowering, magical themes.
