From our heritage of ancient Mesopotamia Bay and Egypt, ancient Arcadia, Ireland, France, and our Indigenous footsteps across the lands to Acadia, the guidance we received was of peace, love, and forgiveness, but also of protection, progress, and preservation. We are divinely guided by our stars, and our recommendation to our world and to our leaders is to protect and preserve our rich heritage and the safety of our communities.

We ask that we honor the American, Francophone, Celtic and Acadian cultures, the Indigenous cultures of America, our rich Acadian heritage and pilgrimage to the ancestral and ancient settlements of our people, and the Acadian communities we share today. We ask that there is no forced mass migration upon our historical communities, and that all community development must be shared and welcomed with open arms by fellow community members. It is clear that Americans have spoken, and we ask that their voices, communities, families, histories, and wishes be respected.

We recognize modern slavery and exploitation, as well as modern forms of “grand derangement,” forced communism, and the enduring harms of warfare that have caused immeasurable pain and suffering to our communities. For this reason, we must recommend spiritual, religious, familial, heritage, cultural, and societal boundaries for all new populations, tribes, families, or foreign communities that are not a part of our heritage or family communities. Any form of mass migration upon our communities, or forced “diversity initiatives” that seek to “arc our population,” power, honorable histories, or truth is no longer welcome.

We set this boundary in order to protect all people and to preserve the communities we love. We are not just protecting our communities; these are our families, friends, our heart, soul and blood. We are the American family, the Acadian and Francophone family, the Celtic family who has endured great hardship, forced servitude, wars, and centuries of settlement, to build all that we have today, all of which is now at risk from modern forms of warfare.

In order to continue to instill the most important and vital value of peace, we move to ask all to respect our boundaries, our country and state borders, our county borders, our laws, and our important rules, regulations and protections. We ask this for the greater good of humanity and for the preservation of our important communities. We honor Great Spirit for this guidance, and we thank all for respecting our wishes for *safety, community freedom, family space and peace* at this time.
