Our conclusions are that we ask our government and elected officials to:

- Halt mass instrumental migration, foreign nation building and modern colonialism.
- End racism directed toward local American communities.
- End the repression and suppression of Americans by modern colonial practices.
- Hold fraudsters, organized criminals, human traffickers, and those responsible for hostile foreign influence operations fully accountable under the law.
- End abuse directed at Americans, including criminal harassment, psychological intimidation, targeted harassment, and political violence.
- Protect America's cultural heritage and ensure that no community is unlawfully targeted because of its heritage, culture, or identity.
- Increase support for local, state, and federal law enforcement, border security, and public safety agencies.
- Strengthen cooperation between local law enforcement and federal agencies.
- End sanctuary city policies through lawful legislative processes.
- Improve education and community awareness so Americans are fully informed about their history, Constitution, rights, responsibilities, and national security.
- Prohibit unlawful foreign interference in American politics and prevent foreign governments or organizations from exercising improper influence over American institutions, consistent with the Constitution and existing law.
- Strengthen protections for victims of violent crime, human trafficking, and home invasions while expanding lawful self-defense rights consistent with state law.
- Expand public safety measures that better protect American families and communities.
- Increase support for Native American tribes, early settler descendant communities, and other historically established American populations through lawful public policy where needed.
- Change the national policy paradigm so Americans are no longer left behind.
- Ensure homeless Americans, especially veterans, receive the highest priority for housing, healthcare, employment assistance, and essential public services.

- Ensure taxpayer dollars are protected from fraud, corruption, abuse, and criminal exploitation.
- Ensure taxpayer-funded spending always prioritizes the needs of American citizens by reviewing foreign aid and domestic budget priorities before undertaking additional international commitments.

We support exercising all lawful constitutional authorities to combat foreign criminal organizations, hostile foreign influence operations, cyber threats, human trafficking, organized crime, and other threats to public safety and national security. Any emergency or wartime authority should be authorized by law and exercised in accordance with the United States Constitution, congressional authority, judicial oversight, and the protection of individual rights and due process.
