Blame Shift

Definition: Redirecting responsibility from the responsible party to another person, group, or circumstance.

Example: "It's not my fault. They made me do it."

PH

Past Humiliation

Definition: Bringing up previous mistakes, embarrassments, or failures to undermine credibility or confidence.

Example: "Remember when you failed before?"

Shaming

Definition: Using embarrassment, ridicule, or social pressure to influence behavior.

Example: "Everyone thinks you're wrong."

Gaslighting

Definition: Causing someone to question their own memory, perception, or judgment.

Example: "That never happened. You're imagining things."

Double Bind

Definition: A situation where every available choice leads to criticism or punishment.

Example: "If you speak up, you're a problem. If you stay silent, you're guilty."

Narrative Control

Definition: Influencing which stories, interpretations, or viewpoints are accepted.

Example: Limiting discussion to one approved explanation.

Reputation Poisoning

Definition: Damaging a person's credibility before they have a chance to present their case.

Example: "Don't listen to them. They're unreliable."

Appeal to Authority

Definition: Claiming something is true primarily because an authority figure says so.

Example: "It must be correct because an expert said it."

Strawman Argument

Definition: Misrepresenting an opponent's position to make it easier to attack.

Example: "You want reform, so you must want to destroy the entire system."

Confirmation Framing

Definition: Presenting information in a way that reinforces an existing belief.

Example: Only highlighting facts that support a preferred conclusion.
