High Threat: Foreign Intelligence

They are no longer just foreign actors but may instead be domestic actors. Concerns include the theft of intellectual property, intelligence gathering, cyberstalking, espionage, and the siphoning of intelligence from homeland security advisers and analysts, with the goal of the continued and deliberate sabotage of U.S. interests.

Individuals acting on behalf of, or providing information to, a foreign government, such as Russia, may be domestic informants or individuals acting on behalf of Russian intelligence.



Highest Current Threat: Domestic “Rights” Organizations Actively Fighting Against Americans’ Rights to Safety, Security, and Free American Only Elections

An active movement is working to repress the American people and undermine their rights to safety, security, and free and fair elections. These organizations may support political agendas, foreign interests, or governing systems that have the capacity to cause severe harm to the American people.

Potential threats include Cold War style political warfare, organized crime, the use of rape as a weapon of war, violent crime, burglary, looting, guerrilla warfare, kidnapping, human trafficking, drug and arms trafficking, smuggling, the early release of individuals convicted of murder or rape, hostile migration strategies, modern colonization, fraud, the purposeful neglect of communities, the creation of modern ghettos, election interference, biological threats, and other forms of political, social, or national destabilization.

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
