Chinese-Linked Marijuana Operations in Maine

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Narrative

NYPD Detective Scannell called regarding a possible missing person. Not official report filled yet. The family was advised she was coming to Maine to start a business. She has been missing since 2/24./2021. [REDACTED]

Above address was a Marijuana growing facility possibly run by a Chinese gang from NY. Neg contact with [REDACTED]. Workers told to call in if they see or hear from her.

Information Gathered

“The Maine Wire has obtained a copy of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security’s list of 270 properties in Maine that federal law enforcement believes are affiliated with Asian **Transnational Criminal Organizations.**”

Federal prosecutors have found a network involving Chinese nationals that operated interconnected illicit marijuana-growing operations in Maine and Massachusetts. According to

the U.S. Department of Justice, the case involved marijuana cultivation, money laundering, smuggling, and **forced labor**. Prosecutors alleged that one defendant, identified as Chen, controlled multiple Maine grow houses and that Chinese nationals were brought into the United States to work at some of the operations.

One Maine property identified in reporting is **57 Conant Road in Turner, Maine**. The property has been associated with **Green Future LLC** and Johnny Wu. Reporting by The Maine Wire has cited Maine State Police records concerning the property and alleged connections to a Chinese organized-crime network.

Another property reported in connection with Chinese-linked illicit marijuana cultivation is **550 North Dexter Road in Sangerville, Maine**. Reporting has described the operation as a large cannabis-growing facility allegedly connected to Chinese interests.

Key Understandings

Chinese nationals working at illicit marijuana operations, Chinese-linked ownership or financing, organized-crime allegations, and human trafficking. The other concern is pesticides.

The U.S. Attorney's Office for the District of Maine stated in 2024 that, at that point in its investigations of illicit marijuana-growing operations in Maine, investigators had not found evidence of human trafficking at the Maine properties they had searched. A later federal case in Massachusetts included allegations of **smuggling and forced labor** involving grow houses in both Maine and Massachusetts.
