

Our Discovery – Abolish Campaigns

We discovered that Democrats refused to acknowledge modern slavery and hold traffickers accountable because they were actively involved in modern forms of exploitation, while supporting traffickers and foreign criminals instead. Their campaigns were conducted underground, supporting White population “arc change” and instrumental migration in order to alter demographics for greater political power.

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XX. CLASSIFICATION KEY

Each organization should ultimately receive one or more of the following classifications:

A — ABOLISH ICE

Explicitly advocates eliminating ICE.

B — DEFUND / DISMANTLE ICE

Explicitly advocates reducing or eliminating ICE funding or dismantling the agency.

C — ICE OUT

Campaigns to remove ICE from a particular state, city, institution, or community.

D — SANCTUARY

Advocates sanctuary policies or restrictions on cooperation with federal immigration enforcement.

E — IMMIGRATION ADVOCACY

Advocates expanded immigration rights, legalization, citizenship, asylum, DACA, TPS, work authorization, or related policies.

F — ANTI-DEPORTATION

Provides or advocates for legal or community assistance intended to prevent deportation.

G — ANTI-DETAINMENT

Opposes immigration detention or advocates release/alternatives to detention.

H — PRISON ABOLITION

Explicitly advocates abolishing prisons.

I — JAIL ABOLITION

Explicitly advocates abolishing jails.

J — DECARCERATION

Advocates reducing incarceration or releasing incarcerated people.

K — POLICE ABOLITION / DEFUND

Explicitly advocates abolition or defunding of police.

L — DECRIMINALIZATION

Advocates removing criminal penalties for particular conduct.

M — BAIL REFORM / ABOLITION

Advocates eliminating or substantially reducing cash bail.

N — PRIVATE DETENTION / PRISON OPPOSITION

Opposes private prisons or private immigration detention.

O — LEGAL DEFENSE

Provides legal representation or legal assistance involving immigration, detention, deportation, or criminal justice.

P — COALITION PARTICIPANT

Participates in a coalition or campaign without sufficient evidence to attribute every position of that coalition to the organization.
