

Thunderbolts and lightning, very, very frightening, Nueva España

This is a map of New Spain, shared for Americans who are aware, attentive, and concerned. Many Americans recognize that we have experienced an invasion alongside a popular Pro Mexico movement that seeks to reclaim portions of America as Mexican or broader Hispanic territory.

This movement is sometimes described as a “Conquistador Revolution,” or conqueror revolution, and is reflected in certain cultural and political expressions, including modern *Day of the Dead* imagery and artwork tied to historic liberation narratives against the Federal Army. Alongside these expressions, sadly, we have experienced a Hispanic organized crime succession and extreme forms of criminal activism.

These more radical activism movements go beyond cultural expression or peaceful protest and include acts of sabotage, intimidation, and efforts to subjugate or harm Americans, including crimes against humanity. It is important to state clearly that, in most cases, Americans and Hispanics live and work together peacefully, and often beautifully, especially among open-minded and law-abiding communities.

However, where individuals or groups seek harm or territory invasion, the outcomes have not been good. This helps explain the rise in arrests and law-enforcement actions we are seeing, as authorities respond to protests and criminal activity.
