What Do I See?

I see Cold War spying and sex slavery as a form of genocide, eugenics and war, the foreign push for open society, and forced mass migrations as crimes against humanity, particularly against the American people. I see critical race theory and globalization used as weapons of marginalization against the American people, and global diversification used as a cruel tool, particularly by foreign aliens, along with anthropological efforts. Based on analysis of historical holocausts and modern genocide, it becomes clear that not all acts by newcomers are in the best interests of the American people, but operate to their own benefit and leverage.

Globalism is a conduit for power, but it is also a suppression of the American voice. Furthermore, slavery is being used as a weapon of war and subjugation. Political action committees have been formed that place foreign voices above and in front of Americans. Americans are overshadowed. Worse, Americans are skillfully targeted by political agents. This includes the targeting of entire families.

We have witnessed skilled population mobilizations that thwart the American people from their homes and residences, the repression of the white American voice, the polarization of race conflicts by foreign enemies, mass land grabs, and the exploitation of American freedoms, including a 5,900 percent increase in birth tourism, along with horrible forms of abuse, slavery and violence.

Whether our government or citizenry has named this a war is not my concern, as much of our country is still growing in awareness of how fruitful domestic war is to our enemies, how much

Americans have lost, and how much foreign enemies have gained. ***I predict this year Americans will experience a “great underground war awakening.”***

I am incredibly grateful to the strong voices, the voices of American men and women who have been successful in speaking truth to us. I feel that I remain a “reservist” to the domestic and global warfront that has been formed against my people and my home, which I love and am a native to.

Not only are Americans pushed to the side, but they are tortured as they witness a very real global war and a hostile global empire formed against them.

There are too many patterned issues in a short period of time, combined with political mobilizations, mass migration politics, hijacked fields of university study, and foreign names that are now in the spotlight. It is evident what the American people are up against and what it will take to save, protect and secure our nation once again: A moratorium on immigration and reasonable efforts to bring justice back to the American people through legal remedy and war powers.
