5. Escalation Roadmap (Checklist)

Step	Action	Notes
1	Mediation	Offer financial/behavioral resolution; document in writing
2	Pro Se Small Claims / Civil Filing	File complaint, serve defendant, present evidence
3	Lawyer Engagement	Retain counsel if business/ministry/public work affected
4	Settlement / Injunction / Damages	Negotiate or proceed to court judgment

Notes: - Keep all communications and evidence documented - Consider confidentiality agreements to protect your monastery or business - Mediation-first approach often resolves disputes faster and at lower cost - Consult a lawyer for significant financial, professional, or public stakes.
