Political and ideological extremism, human trafficking, revenge politics, subversion, crime, and violence create activism realms that lead to holocaust-like outcomes when left unchecked. People naturally seek to protect themselves from predators in all forms, including all races, and will protect their family and heritage. At this time in history, as an American, I feel incredibly protective of my people and I am very upset by how Americans have been treated and victimized by newcomer nations.

Furthermore, diversity initiatives, especially in the social spheres, have disturbingly ostracized white males to the point that they are nearly nonexistent; they are rarely seen in advertisements. We are, as a white race, literally watching our own erasure, and when speaking of human right's harms, we are villainized and penalized. American whites are not "Puritans"; we are a free society and a very compassionate society. However, there are patriarchal systems that we inherit, and they create a sense of safety and security.

Activists have seemingly made it their duty to attack these same systems, essentially attacking our fathers and calling it "activism," under the cloak of human rights. Human rights have never, ever, ever required the dehumanization of one to support the other, and that is exactly what activism spheres have done. They have victimized white Americans, particularly males in support of all others, including outside nations. Essentially, they have raised the world on the shoulders of white males and thought it acceptable to do so.

Being invested in activism opens one's eyes to activists. During my time as an activist post-pandemic, I witnessed the "deep state" in real time. They are, in fact, running trafficking rings within these spheres, and white Americans are, no doubt, being targeted. Furthermore, Americans of all colors at this time in history are in harms way. We are all essentially the pinata of the new age sphere. Whether it is our public servants or our people, being American today means we are par for the violent course.

Rather than make this long-winded, I would like to briefly state that I feel that newcomers to America have brought with them a new "Trail of Tears."
