7. Of course, it is free speech. But it is clear that it has not been celebrated or honored in the same way Black speech or minority speech has been. I find this concerning. I feel many people have been misled by those who were, frankly, their own “supremacists” within activism and rights spheres. The patterns emerge.
8. How many attacks have White protest communities endured where we, the rest of the world, simply did not know better than to take the Left’s word for it? Who is the Left, anyway? *Big Names, Next Paper.*

9. Maybe it is time to go back through and challenge the smear campaigns, smearing the campaigns?
10. It is evident that organizations such as the KKK exist and do cause harm. We all know, *we all know*. Extremism loves to show its ugly face in activist spheres. But as the saying goes, “we are who we hang with.” My point is that activists simply need more accountability, on all sides. Who is? ... Never mind.
