Opinion:

The arguments of the organization and its eight million supporters remove protections for American safety in order to protect certain racial groups they advocate as being targeted by what we see as normal and necessary public safety and national security measures. Within the organization's advocacy efforts, there is little to no accountability for criminal activity, nor is there any meaningful effort to assist federal and local law enforcement officers or address it. There is no doubt that their positions create racial disparities affecting American communities, which are being relentlessly targeted and forced to bear the brunt of the burden and cost. The organization has demonstrated extremism and racial bias through its advocacy.

Sadly, they are joined by millions of others who are actively campaigning against public safety and national security while portraying the issue as one of racism. Over and over, innocent communities are blamed for the safety risks created within what they describe as "Black and Brown communities." Criminal enterprises, mobs, gangs, traffickers, smugglers, and terrorist organizations are not "Black and Brown communities." The distinction should be recognized. Advocacy that opposes public safety measures presents not just a human rights issue, but is the pro-terror stance of our time. This stance, shared by foreign enemies, and its relentless advocacy and lawfare efforts against our public servants, pose a significant national security risk that is amounting to a Cold War for the American people.



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
