

The Forts of the American People

This is spiritual protection. A fortified heart remains humane without being naïve.

The Body — The Living Temple

Our bodies are not public property. They are **temples** entrusted to us.

To *FORT UP* the body means: - Protecting physical safety and health - Respecting personal boundaries - Rejecting coercion, intrusion, and misuse

A fortified body honors life and resists harm without apology.

The Home — The Personal Stronghold

The home is where restoration occurs. It is where families gather, where peace is meant to live.

To *FORT UP* the home means: - Defending privacy and property - Preserving order, safety, and quiet dignity - Refusing intrusion — physical, digital, or ideological

A fortified home allows people to rest, recover, and remain whole.

The Community — The Shared Fort

Community is built on trust, contribution, and mutual respect. When boundaries collapse, communities fracture.

To *FORT UP* the community means: - Protecting shared standards and laws - Rejecting exploitation masked as virtue - Standing for order, accountability, and fairness

A fortified community is safe, secure and stable!
