More people appear to be moving to New Hampshire and Maine from other places. There is potential for intelligence gathering through “delivery” and truck opportunities. There is no excuse for any sort of targeting of another human being. We have resources and contacts available that we can contact in the case that we are hurt, in trouble, or notice something unusual.

I write, for example, and communicate, but I always remain kind and compassionate toward others, no matter who they are, their race, political stance, gender choice, etc. Being a moderate conservative is a great foundation for communicating with all people and remaining somewhat neutral. With mass, rapid, and forced demographic changes, as well as “algorithmic-like changes,” weaponized migration, cultural shifts, and American targeting, it is acceptable to feel how we feel and to communicate how we feel. We can do so in a way that remains humane, cordial, and kind.

In other cultures, there are different cultural norms, and Americans are often very good at “leaning into” other cultures in America so that others may feel more comfortable. I think this is a wonderful practice. It is important to do our best to make others feel comfortable as well. There may be travelers or others who are simply visiting, and I think it is important for Americans to remain hospitable to travelers.

Still, we are also experiencing quite a radical dichotomy, and we do not actually feel comfortable with our culture changing this much. There is a natural inclination to want to put boundaries up and say no. I think the choice of attitude and how people behave and act is really up to Americans at this time. We should also be able to say no when we feel uncomfortable and not be harmed for having American values and boundaries surrounding our culture, demographics, and the overall experience of weaponized mass migration.

Our experience, as we have realized, is a form of war and particularly involves targeting White races. This may not be seen in some places but is more visible in others. I did witness more White targeting in states like Arizona and Ohio. I also noticed visible demographic shifts in New York and Boston and along highway routes, with potential foreign enemies and cartel activity in the area.

I also noticed more undocumented immigrants. At this time in history, there are currently tens of millions of undocumented immigrants. The concern is less with legal migrants and more with traffickers, cartels, gang members, violent mobs, smugglers, anti-White or anti-White-supremacy demographic activists, activist movements, thieves, looters, organized criminals, and those who target others because of their race.

For example, there may be agriculture or hospitality workers who are migrants and are here building a life for themselves. They may have nice families to care for and may generally be very polite and kind. Unfortunately, the politics of our time is making the experience difficult to navigate for many Americans. This is why it is important to always remain kind and cordial and to remember to contact the authorities and report suspicious activity when it is experienced.
