

Union of Saints Dating Covenant and Safety Oath

Preamble

This Covenant is offered by the Sisters of Safety of the Union of Saints. It exists to protect dignity, peace, health, and future generations. It is rooted in truth, consent, bodily autonomy, and mutual respect. This Covenant is not coercive. Participation is voluntary. Acceptance signifies understanding and agreement.

Purpose

To establish clear expectations for dating and partnership, to define non negotiable boundaries, and to provide notice of consequences when boundaries are violated, including termination of contact, documentation, police reporting, and lawful remedies.

Definitions

Sister refers to a woman of the Union of Saints. Brother for the purposes of this Covenant refers to any individual who is offered, receives, or signs this Covenant as a dating or relational partner. The term Brother in this document does not denote religious membership, spiritual status, or standing within the Union of Saints, and is used solely for contractual clarity. Consent means clear, enthusiastic, ongoing agreement that may be withdrawn at any time. Safety includes physical, emotional, sexual, financial, digital, and spiritual safety.

Affirmations Required of the Brother

By signing, I affirm that I understand and accept the following: 1. Women are sovereign over their bodies, time, choices, and futures. 2. Consent is required always and may be withdrawn without explanation. 3. Respect is shown through action, consistency, and restraint. 4. I am responsible for my conduct regardless of mood, stress, alcohol, or influence. 5. Equality does not require dominance. Leadership does not require control.

What We Tolerate

The following are welcomed and expected: 1. Kindness, honesty, patience, and accountability. 2. Clear communication and listening without interruption or intimidation. 3. Respect for boundaries related to time, touch, sexuality, health, and privacy. 4. Support for education, career, creativity, and wellbeing. 5. Shared joy, friendship, humor, and mutual growth. 6. Acceptance of a woman caring for her sexual and reproductive health.

What We Do Not Tolerate

The following are strictly prohibited and constitute immediate breach: 1. Any form of coercion, pressure, manipulation, or intimidation. 2. Sexual contact without consent or after consent is withdrawn. 3. Verbal abuse, name calling, shaming, threats, or

humiliation. 4. Control over clothing, friendships, work, movement, finances, or beliefs. 5. Surveillance, stalking, digital harassment, or access to devices without permission. 6. Retaliation when boundaries are set. 7. Ideologies or behaviors that degrade women or promote domination. 8. Lying about identity, status, intentions, or exclusivity.

Zero Tolerance Notice

Violations may result in immediate termination of contact without discussion. Serious violations will be documented and may lead to police reports, restraining orders, civil claims, or other lawful action. This document serves as notice of boundaries and consequences.

Health and Integrity

We honor the body as a living system of cycles and care. Shaming a woman for tending to her health, including sexual health, is prohibited. Privacy is mandatory.

Children and the Future

This Covenant protects the possibility of family, children, and a stable future. Any behavior that undermines safety, fertility, or wellbeing is a breach.

Term and Revocation

This Covenant applies from the date of signature and remains in effect during any dating or intimate contact. Either party may revoke participation at any time. Revocation does not erase accountability for prior conduct.

Governing Law

This Covenant is intended as a values based notice and agreement. It does not replace the law. Local, state, and federal laws apply.

Oath of the Sisters of Safety

We vow to protect one another, to speak truth, to document harm, and to choose peace and dignity. We stand for shared humanity and the future of our children.
