Local Tucson Grocery & Specialty Markets

These stores *frequently* carry exotic produce like **soursop (guanábana)** and **durian** — especially **frozen fruit, pulp, juices, or seasonal fresh fruit**.



Asian & International Grocery Stores

- **Lee Lee International Supermarkets**
Large international grocery with diverse produce. Good chance for exotic fruits & frozen tropical items.
- **Sandyi Oriental Market**
Asian grocery with varied produce selection — may carry tropical fruit products.
- **G & L Import Export**
International market with imported foods and occasional exotic produce.
- **Kimpo Oriental Market**
Asian grocery with specialty items; ask about exotic fruit availability.
- **Grant-Stone Supermarket**
Asian international market; people have reported finding unusual tropical fruits here.
- **Pamilihan Pinoy Asian Groceries**
Filipino grocery store — sometimes stocks tropical produce or frozen fruit products.
- **Nick's Sari-Sari Store**
Filipino grocery and convenience market; check for frozen durian and fruit pulps.



Other Grocery & Produce Options

These stores might *occasionally* have imported or seasonal exotic fruit products (fresh, frozen, juiced or pulped):

- **Sprouts Farmers Market** – Produce & specialty aisles.
 - **Whole Foods Market** – Organic/unique produce selection.
 - **Natural Grocers** – Fresh produce & specialty aisles.
 - **AJ's Fine Foods** – Premium grocery with varied produce.

Online Ordering (Ships to Tucson, AZ)

If your local markets **don't have fresh fruit in stock**, these online options are reliable for **soursop & durian** shipped directly to your home.

Soursop Options

- Fresh soursop (when in season) from tropical fruit delivery services.
- Soursop pulp or juice products (canned, bottled, or frozen) via specialty online markets.

Durian Options

- Frozen durian (common varieties like **Monthong** or **Musang King**) from Asian grocery delivery services.
- Durian pulp packs — easy to use in smoothies or desserts.

⚠ **Tip:** Frozen durian is *much more consistently available* than fresh durian.

Shopping Tips

- ✓ **Call ahead** before visiting a store — exotic fruits aren't always in stock.
 - ✓ Ask produce managers if they can **order** soursop or durian for you.
 - ✓ If fresh fruit is unavailable, check for **frozen** fruit, **pulp**, **juice**, or **canned** products.
 - ✓ Delivery apps like **Instacart**, **Weee!**, or store-specific services might offer tropical fruits too.
