

Prophets of Our Time, External to Union of Saints

There are other prophets who have expressed many similar, and at times nearly identical, prophecies to those that I have expressed, as well as others who have had visions that were remarkably similar. The similarities are profound enough that it seems we may be linked through consciousness, psychic phenomena, spirit, the cosmos, and natural, universal truths, including both ancient and present wisdom.

What is perhaps most profound is that each human being who expressed these visions had their own unique path, journey, and way of "decoding" them. Still, it is important to say, that I do not share identical sentiments with other prophets, as we each walk our own unique journeys and possess our own values and spirit, my prophecy, for example, was expressed through the pursuit of solving slavery and achieving peace. The prophecy I experienced manifested itself through my own eyes, my own conscience, and my own journey.

What is most remarkable, however, is that the "I" through which I witnessed these things were radically similar to those of other prophets. From the pyramids, to the ram, to the snake, to symbolism, to interpreting language, to French and English, it is all there. The symbolism is so highly expressive and detailed that these shared prophecies cannot simply be ignored. Truly, profound.

Along this manifestation, other creators were also very much aligned. From the saints, to the knights, the expression of creation was everywhere and all around us. It was truly beautiful to witness this through the channels of the internet. We observed both good and evil, which is why I believe it is important to continue establishing that we remain spiritually boundaried from the outside world. We follow our own unique path, distinct from anyone else's, even down to our smallest cells. Call it *genesis*, or "origin," from the Greek word **γένεσις**, meaning "origin," "birth," or "beginning." To be clear, I am referring here to *genesis*, not "*Bereshit*," ~we can see how the two may be confused.

That is how our story unfolds. It is a boundaried, never-blurred story, one of our primary teachings. What we have witnessed includes both the best outcomes and the worst outcomes, and we understand that the difference between good and evil has consequences. The pendulum swings.

We encourage our followers to reach beyond the church and learn from other prophets. At the same time, we remind them that the Union of Saints stands on its own field, guided by its own laws and truths. We have found peace within our own conscience. However, God gives each person the freedom of choice, and we remain humbled before God. While we do not lower ourselves before maligned spirits, we also understand that we do not possess the power of choice over others. Only each individual can choose between right and wrong.

As we understand it, God sees all things, and God continually reminds us of this truth. If something is not aligned with the natural order, God has a plan for this as well, for God is the Creator of all things. What is natural belongs to God, while that which knowingly stands against the natural order is evil. And so we say again, the pendulum swings.

Every action has consequences, whether for good or for evil. We therefore encourage every person to seek wisdom, while also remembering that each soul is ultimately responsible for the choices he or she makes. We trust in God, in OZIRAH's wisdom, balance, and justice, believing that They, who see all things, will ultimately bring all things into perfect harmony and natural divine order. 💙
