For those keeping pace, this negative trajectory of foreign influence must be changed.

→ Supporting military, police, border patrol, U.S. Marshals, and ICE measures is a means of “survival” for the American people during an era of highly sophisticated targeting, trafficking, forced territorial colonialism, violence, and harm.

→ Elect U.S.-born officials who support the protection of American culture and the American people.

→ Do not accept forced cultural assimilation as normal. Examples may include flagicide/desecration, territorial claims, dehumanization, or racism, including ethnic racism.

→ Question homelessness and “ghettoized” trafficking hub areas, as well as the leadership and policies associated with them.

→ Critically examine the statements and policies of foreign leaders and immigrants to help ensure that truth and accountability remain protected.

→ Say no to domestic leaders who support politically engineered mass migration initiatives, such as relocating hundreds of thousands of people from one region into another city over a short period of time.

→ Understand Jewish, religious, and foreign political movements, as well as how they may differ from the political views or priorities of native-born populations.

→ Understand that immigration policy and Native American policy are distinct issues with different historical, legal, and political goals.

→ Mainstream media and propaganda are often left-leaning and ideologically biased, with centralized ownership structures and perspectives that may not reflect the full population.

→ Activist rhetoric is sometimes repeated in alignment with leadership movements that are ideologically driven rather than fact-based, compassionate, or logical. Many forms of activism have contributed to extremism, violence, or social disruption, particularly when disobedience and disruption are encouraged without consideration for those harmed in the process.

→ If you are an activist, politician, or public figure, understand that the political arena can be highly volatile for women, and that some women may be targeted by

traffickers or exploitative individuals posing as romantic interests or “boyfriends.” Remain tactical, self-protective and vigilant.
