Victims

1. Brasfield & Gorrie
2. Law enforcement officer shot, injured
3. Protester shot, killed

Reported Activity and Recovered Items

- Armed protest activity reported
- Weapons and materials allegedly recovered, including:
 - Firearms
 - Molotov cocktails
 - Firebomb devices
 - Improvised traps
 - Controlled substances

The Union of Saints does not align with certain human rights organizations or activist groups where patterns have emerged of excusing human rights abuses in the name of “protest.” We recognize a concerning trend in which such justifications are used to overlook or minimize harmful or violent conduct. The dehumanization of public servants, journalists, or objectors has also become normalized.

We further take the position that destruction of property at this scale rises to the level of conduct that may be characterized as terrorism.

Furthermore, these are not isolated or inadvertent events, but rather patterns of criminal conduct that have become normalized within certain activist cultures and must be addressed and prosecuted where necessary.
