Jewish, Black and Extreme Left Influence In Media, *Post Pandemic Trends*

“**Around 2020**, several “influential” style guides, especially the Associated Press (AP), updated their rules to capitalize “Black” when referring to people in a cultural or racial sense, while keeping “white” lowercase. Other outlets like The New York Times and The Washington Post made similar choices.

Their reasoning generally included:

- “Black” is often treated as a shared cultural and historical identity (including the legacy of slavery and diaspora), so they chose to capitalize it.
- “White” was not capitalized to avoid reinforcing it as a unified cultural identity or aligning with historical uses by “white supremacist movements,” which often capitalize the term.

What you’re seeing isn’t a universal rule, it’s a style choice that spread through media and publishing, **not a formal change in the English language itself.**

Union of Saints feels that this stylistic change is “supremacy-natured” and racist and that the opposite should be true: that Whites are a distinct population whose cultural identity should be reinforced and celebrated, just as any other culture. This form of erasure is beyond distasteful, it is disturbing, as it erases White identity and, in their view, actively puts Whites down in order to make “Black” identity appear more prominent in academic and media sources.

This shift has roots in extreme racial politics and ideology, and it is important to avoid conforming to ideologies that suppress, target and subjugate groups of human beings. There is no justification for dehumanization at this level, and it reflects a greater issue within the current cultural and historical moment.

This can be described as a form of group-based or “clan” mentality that targets Whites, sadly, gaining traction through political influence. The problem is that it can lead to dehumanization and suppression. Worse, it can vilify Whites based on ideology rather than individual reality. This is not progress, or evolution, it is Racism with a capital R. *Americans deserve better than this.*
