

## US Citizens Experiencing Crimes Against Humanity

We witnessed the transfer of United States land and assets to foreign nations enabled through administrative tools such as the autopen and permissive federal approvals.

Through land purchases and corporate acquisitions Democratic leadership **sold us out**. This is no longer the United States acting in the interest of its own people. It reflects an enemy land grab carried out through politics.

Chinese companies became investors in United States agricultural assets in the early 2010s. No China does not see the world the way Americans do. They do not hold the same loyalty to this country or its people. They see our territory as one to be conquered. Our leaders invited external powers into our home and allowed them access to our land, food systems and communities.

Researching these understandings felt like digging for hidden American graves. Everywhere I looked there were signs of death, violence and war. *The patterns are synchronized, they repeat themselves and very fluently, these harms compare to WW2.*

In 2013 **Smithfield Foods** was acquired by **WH Group**. That deal transferred control of roughly one hundred forty six thousand acres of farmland tied to pork production. It was one of the largest foreign acquisitions of United States agricultural land at the time.

More Chinese linked land purchases followed in later years. Many were small or medium parcels. Some were located near sensitive or strategic areas including a purchase in North Dakota around 2021.

That same factory later experienced one of the worst COVID outbreaks in history. It was a Republican voting town. People died. Workers were forced to work. The virus spread rapidly. *Yet another pattern. May compare to victory campaigns.*

Who benefits Investors? The same insulated corporate class that profits during crisis? The same pattern appears across industries including pharmaceutical corporations. Every line of research points in the same direction. The ghettoizing and the benefited.

At the same time population composition in certain areas has changed so dramatically that there are now few Americans left in communities that were American for generations. American life completely altered into a foreign country, Mexico. Shared language customs and institutions weakened. American-English speaking is rare. Racism against White Americans not only persists, but is now out-casting, permanently excluding, and psychological torture. Americans are strangers in their own towns.

When population change is paired with coercive policy, exclusion and retaliatory harm against civilians and religious institutions this moves beyond activism or politics.

A systematic campaign to impose cultural replacement through violence, force and coercion followed by retaliatory attacks on civilians and religious institutions in response to resistance

constitutes persecution and satisfies the legal threshold for crimes against humanity under international law as defined by the **International Criminal Court** and the **Rome Statute**.

The beneficiaries are foreign and corporate interests. The cost is paid by the American people. The result is loss of culture, a people and life.

Our nation is being sold off piece by piece to those **who seek to harm us**.
