

Human Right's Violations & Harms - Universal Declaration of Human Rights:

Violence & Physical Harm

- Genocide
- Torture or cruel, inhuman, degrading treatment
- Extrajudicial killings
- Enforced disappearances
- War crimes (including targeting civilians)
- Police brutality / excessive force
- Assault or targeted physical attacks
- Targeted violence against public servants (judges, law enforcement, military, officials)

Sexual Exploitation & Abuse

- Human trafficking (labor or sex trafficking)
- Rape and sexual violence (including as a weapon of war)
- Child exploitation / child labor / child marriage
- Forced prostitution
- Non-consensual image sharing (revenge pornography)

Freedom & Civil Rights Violations

- Censorship / suppression of free speech
- Arbitrary arrest or detention
- Political imprisonment
- Denial of fair trial / due process
- Unlawful surveillance / invasion of privacy
- Restrictions on movement (travel bans, forced confinement)
- Harassment, coercion, or intimidation interfering with lawful duties (including public servants)

Political Participation & Democracy

- Denial of the right to vote
- Election interference or fraud
- Coercion or intimidation of voters or candidates
- Barring individuals or groups from public office
- Targeting candidates or officials to undermine democratic processes

Discrimination & Targeted Harm

- Racial discrimination or racially motivated violence (against any race, including white individuals)
- Ethnic or caste-based oppression
- Gender/sex discrimination

- Religious persecution
- Discrimination based on sexual orientation or identity
- Disability discrimination
- Hate crimes (violence or property damage motivated by bias)

Religious Freedom & Protection from Targeted Harm

- Interference with the peaceful practice of religion
- Harassment or intimidation of people attending religious services
- Disruption of religious gatherings or ceremonies
- Coercion to adopt or abandon religious beliefs
- Violence, threats, or harassment directed at churches or religious communities

Property, Livelihood & Animal-Related Harm

- Arson against homes, businesses, or places of worship
- Looting, theft, or destruction of property
- Identity theft and financial exploitation
- Targeting livelihoods or employment as retaliation
- Harm or cruelty toward animals tied to coercion, intimidation, or destruction of livelihood

Verbal Abuse, Threats & Harassment

- Credible threats of violence
- Persistent harassment or intimidation (offline or online)
- Verbal abuse targeting individuals or groups based on identity (race, religion, etc.)
- Incitement to violence

Economic & Social Rights Violations

- Forced labor / modern slavery
- Unsafe or exploitative working conditions
- Denial of education
- Denial of healthcare
- Extreme poverty tied to systemic neglect
- Lack of access to clean water, food, or basic necessities

Cultural & Community Rights Violations

- Forced assimilation (erasure of language or culture)
- Destruction of cultural or religious heritage
- Denial of indigenous land rights
- Suppression of language or religious expression
- Targeting cultural communities or institutions for harm

Identity, Legal Status & Family Rights

- Denial of citizenship or nationality

- Statelessness
- Refusal to issue identity documents
- Forced separation of families
- Arbitrary interference with family life
- Forced marriage

Assembly, Association & Belief

- Banning or violently suppressing peaceful protests
- Criminalizing lawful organizations or unions
- Retaliation for association with lawful groups
- Forced ideological or belief conformity

Privacy, Dignity & Personal Boundaries in Intimate Spaces

- Unlawful intrusion into private or intimate spaces (e.g., bathrooms, changing areas)
- Failure to provide reasonable privacy protections where individuals are in states of undress
- Coercion or forced exposure in situations involving bodily privacy
- Policies or practices that disregard personal dignity and safety in shared intimate environments
- Harassment, intimidation, or exploitation occurring in gender-segregated or intimate spaces

Environmental & Health-Related Rights

- Exposure to unsafe or toxic environments
- Failure to protect populations from severe pollution
- Denial of a safe and healthy living environment

Rights of Vulnerable or Protected Groups

- Violations against children (neglect, abuse, recruitment into conflict)
- Violations against refugees or asylum seekers
- Prisoner abuse or inhumane detention conditions
- Elder abuse
- Violations of rights of persons with disabilities

Collective Punishment & Group-Based Harm

- Punishing families or communities for actions of individuals
- Broad measures intentionally harming civilian populations
- Siege, deprivation, or forced conditions affecting entire groups

Information, Technology & Modern Violations

- Mass digital surveillance without consent
- Online harassment and cyber exploitation
- Deepfake abuse / identity misuse

- Internet shutdowns
- Algorithmic discrimination (bias in automated systems)
- Doxxing or coordinated harassment campaigns

● Core Principle

Human rights protections are **universal and neutral**. They apply to:

- All races
- All religions (including church communities)
- Civilians and public servants alike

Specific harmful acts (violence, coercion, discrimination, etc.), especially when directed at individuals or groups based on identity or belief.
