

Florida Residents May Be Living in Chronic Pain

Just one county over, 42,000 pounds of pesticides were fogged into the atmosphere near residential buildings, leaving a sting in the air and a white chalk-like residue on the ground—lethal enough to kill birds, frogs, and fish. Insects, bees, butterflies, and horseflies have no chance.

Residents complain of thyroid pain—this could be an early warning sign. The same company that manufactured Zyklon B and COVID-19 vaccines is currently involved in lawsuits worth billions, their products have caused cancer.

Spraying has repeatedly occurred in indoor environments as well—on walls, tubs, near beds, closets and cabinets.

As I write this, I hold my neck in pain. I feel as though I am now “radioactive,” experiencing aching pain near electronic devices, to the point that I must wear a brace or keep a book between myself and radio frequencies. Although I have left the area, the pesticides that seeped heavily into my skin, made me toxic to the touch, this diminished much of my healthy collagen. These chemicals are said to cause rapid, early-onset aging—and even early death.

This is a warning. A truth.

These chemicals may lower fertility, contribute to early menopause, and increase cancer risk. Combined with pesticide exposure in water—through breathing and bathing—the effects may compound. Residents report rapid new “skin growths” that appear in clusters, which may raise concerns about melanoma.

I am still in pain. I am hoping for a full recovery, but I remain unsure whether that is possible.
