

Community Watch Summary

Location: Tucson, Arizona

Day: Wednesday

Observations

Community watch observations have noted the following activity within the area:

- “Drug block rings” observed within the neighborhood.
- Presence of individuals described as “squatters.”
- Individuals believed to be undocumented immigrants observed driving through the area, often in trucks.
- Behavior noted includes hiding, glaring, and movement that gives the impression of “dark energy.”

Purpose of Record

This document serves as a brief community watch summary to record observations within the neighborhood. These notes reflect what has been seen and perceived during routine awareness of the area and are intended for documentation and community awareness.

Rather than calling the police, other options may include:

They enforce city property maintenance codes that protect neighborhood safety and livability.

2. Encampment Reporting (for Squatters or Camps)

The city has a specific **Homeless Encampment Reporting Tool** and hotline.

Reports go through a city process that may include outreach, cleanup, or enforcement if needed.

3. Tucson 311 Service

For non-emergency neighborhood issues such as public nuisance or sanitation concerns.

- **Dial: 311** within Tucson city limits.

4. Immigration Enforcement Tip Line

For concerns related to immigration enforcement, tips can be reported to **U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE)**, which operates under the **U.S. Department of Homeland Security**.

- **Encampment or squatters in public areas:** call **(520) 791-2540** or use the encampment reporting tool.

 - **Immigration enforcement concerns:** contact the **ICE tip line (866-347-2423)**.
