

Foreign War

We *don't* need foreigners coming here and going, “I know my rights,” then hopping aboard the “coalition” and supporting “diversity” initiatives seeking to alter the “demographics.” This is nothing more than a glorified foreign war front, and it targets the American people—our families, our people, and our communities.

Types of Warfare

- **Information warfare** — attempts to influence people through propaganda, messaging, narratives, or manipulation of information.
- **Political warfare** — efforts to influence political attitudes, institutions, or public policy without conventional military force.
- **Psychological warfare (PSYOP)** — attempts to influence perceptions, emotions, or behavior.
- **Fourth-generation warfare (4GW)** — a broader concept involving non-state actors, political influence, information operations, and social pressure rather than conventional battlefield combat.
- **Transnational influence operations** — organized efforts crossing national borders to influence political or social outcomes.
- **Foreign interference** — when a foreign government or foreign-linked actor covertly or improperly attempts to influence another country's political or social processes.

Foreigners participating in coalitions or supporting diversity initiatives: A foreign war front or foreign interference, foreign direction, financing, coordination, and intentional influence operations.

Please note there is a stark difference between lending support to the American people and supporting coalitions against them or that seek to alter the demographic landscape and culture. Many American communities welcome immigrants for seasonal help and sustainability efforts, hospitality, agriculture, the food industry, etc., and they are a great help. They make great friendships with Americans and are a great aid to the overall seasonal job industry.

Still, Americans must have boundaries with any foreign efforts to alter their culture, demographics, or politics. Americans must also remain vigilant with global wars, human slavery, and organized crime, including drug and arms trafficking. Furthermore, Americans should remain wary of any potential cultural harms that may arise due to foreign migration.
