1. **Bram Stoker's Dracula (1992)** – Coppola's lush, romantic, gothic take on Dracula.
2. **Interview with the Vampire (1994)** – Moody, sensual, and beautifully acted.
3. **Nosferatu (1922)** – Iconic silent-era vampire horror; eerie and timeless.
4. **Nosferatu the Vampyre (1979)** – Werner Herzog's poetic remake; haunting visuals.

Modern & Stylish Vampires

5. **Only Lovers Left Alive (2013)** – Slow, indie, atmospheric; vampires as existential artists.
6. **Thirst (2009, Korean)** – Stylish, morally complex vampire drama.
7. **Byzantium (2012)** – Gothic, emotional, and visually elegant vampire story.

Horror & Atmospheric

8. **Let the Right One In (2008, Swedish)** – Haunting, subtle, beautiful vampire tale.
9. **Let Me In (2010, US remake)** – Dark, moody, faithful to the Swedish original.
10. **Near Dark (1987)** – Vampire western; gritty, stylish, unconventional.

11. **The Hunger (1983)** – Stylish, erotic vampire film with David Bowie and Catherine Deneuve.
12. **Blade (1998)** – Cool, slick action-horror with vampires; urban gothic vibe.
13. **Fright Night (1985)** – Horror-comedy done stylishly; still dark and fun.

Animated / Fantasy-Adjacent

14. **Vampire Hunter D: Bloodlust (2000, anime)** – Dark, gothic, beautifully animated.
15. **Blood: The Last Vampire (2000, anime)** – Cool, moody, stylistic vampire action.
