Union of Saints Votes No On Sanctuary City Acts – Grave Danger to Americans

Supports Shut Down Sanctuary Policies

“On April 22, ICE arrested an illegal alien from Guatemala who had been charged with 15 felony counts of possessing obscene material and 2 felony counts of possessing child pornography with intent to distribute. ICE had lodged a detainer with Fairfax County, Virginia in October 2025, explicitly asking the county not to release him. Fairfax County ignored the detainer, released him four days later without notifying ICE, and left a man facing 17 felony charges free in the community for six months until ICE tracked him down.

This pattern repeats across the country. Fairfax County alone has refused detainers for individuals charged with murder, sexual assault, and child exploitation in just the past few weeks. Sanctuary jurisdictions are actively undermining federal immigration enforcement and putting communities at risk by releasing dangerous individuals that ICE has specifically asked them to hold.

The Judiciary Committee has already passed H.R. 7640, the Shut Down Sanctuary Policies Act, which would cut off federal law enforcement grants to jurisdictions that refuse to cooperate with ICE detainers and redirect those funds to jurisdictions that do. This bill is sitting on the House floor waiting for a vote. I urge you to bring it to the floor immediately. No community should have to live with the consequences of a local politician's decision to release a child predator rather than cooperate with federal law enforcement.”
