From my local observations, this explains the nice bikes stopping by and parking periodically near the encampments. It was like experiencing a whirlwind of issues, a ring around the posie, an encircling of our block, one issue after another. They moved in and developed their zone.

Please keep children away from homeless encampments. We do our best to get the word out, but they are often hidden just far enough off the roadways that they are not easily seen, though they are also out in the open. Some refer to these as "open-air drug markets," or zones.

These are "war" dynamics that we are dealing with daily. Exhausting to the point of "war-time slavery." So what to do?

Recruit, recruit, recruit: I do feel that town and city police should be granted federal privileges and that these agencies should have federal protections. Civilian task forces and deputizing trusted Americans are good ideas.

→ For example, carefully screened civilian volunteer programs, paid volunteer programs, neighborhood watch initiatives, reserve officer programs, and community partnerships that assist law enforcement while operating under professional training and supervision.

→ Reduce funding in areas that are not deemed necessary and increase investment in local communities, public safety, and defense. More manpower.
