

# Quick Notes from Cowdrey 3.23.26

1. Traffickers: Traffickers hunt for people, coerce them, take from them, exploit them, and force them.  
→ Hold traffickers [mainstream, international, war-front] accountable through legal remedies and criminal reporting.
2. Santa Letter Writing: Santa communication via letter writing is the best method of expressing our “professional opinion” on a subject. It should be logic-oriented, use critical thinking skills, and remain unbiased. It should also be polite and honor the spirit, keeping communications both positive and truthful. Globally, ~10–30% know what a logical fallacy is; most people rely on intuition rather than formal logic training.
3. Foreign and Domestic Enemies: Nondocumented immigrant activists and domestic activists now support BRICS and other international alliances in the USA. At this time in history, organized violent crime rings have contributed to war-related attrition affecting U.S. citizens. It is evident that the U.S. must protect itself. While we as citizens have little control over the wars the U.S. enters, we understand that the global environment is increasingly hostile toward the U.S. post-Palestine. Furthermore, Russia has committed to harming the U.S. through Cold War–style strategies. War dynamics are incredibly complex, but we can simplify our reasoning by rejecting foreign adversaries operating within our territory. Not all immigrants are enemies, this is not the case, however, the U.S. must protect itself during times of war.
