
Mass Exclusion Local Native Populations

In any country, the mass exclusion of local native populations would be frowned upon; however, in the United States it is often celebrated and considered “intelligent” and “educated.” While local populations experience erasure, racism, hatred, political sabotage, arson, bombings, economic targeting, slavery, warfare, and violence, they are still blamed, silenced, and further excluded.

Migrating or “modern colonial” populations have widely turned their backs on local populations, yet locals are cast as lower class, uneducated, criminals and territorial thieves, “colonizers,” “racists,” and “Nazis” for merely doing their best to protect themselves and their families from territorial and slavery warfare and resulting crime waves, including the kidnapping of children, excessive labor, and the mass rape and torture of women.

Normal culture is targeted in mass political campaigns, as foreign flags are hoisted. Local populations raise theirs. “We are still here,” they say, as they are disparaged, racially mocked, and abused simply for being American.

The case is settled; the truth is known. Americans have been mass targeted, and so here is where we draw the line. If you are on American territory, you are either on the American side, or you may be seen as our *foreign or domestic enemy*.
