

This Is Where We Draw the Line – The Anti American

I am setting boundaries with alternative societies within the United States, such as the communism movement and pro-foreign-enemy movement, pro-mass-migration and genocide movement, and modern warfarists. I am setting boundaries with those perpetuating race wars, against me as a White woman, the war against Whites. I am setting boundaries with those who want to harm American heritage and their culture.

I am setting boundaries with those who target blondes, particularly happy blondes who used to thrive within our society but now face constant degradation, cruelties, and harms. It is rare to see a curly-haired blonde in our society today, and this shows how much our culture has deterred us from honoring White girls and boys, men and women. I am setting boundaries with new cultures who are actively seeking to erase culture, heritage, or religion and spirit from Americans.

I am setting boundaries with foreign parades and harms against American traditions and culture. I am setting boundaries with race activists who harm Whites but remain forever victims who blame Whites, particularly for the wrongs they themselves perpetuate, including war games, assaults, arson, and rape. I am setting boundaries with those who fail to acknowledge modern slavery and those modern enemies who are perpetuating it due to race and politics.

No human should be enslaved, and her assailant released freely into our modern world. This is our great divide. I am expressing this now as a White American who, for her whole life, was conditioned and indoctrinated into believing that my value as a White woman was less than that of others who were of different races and cultures.

I was taught that I could be harmed in any sort of way and that it never mattered, and I was never to talk about it. Whether by man or woman, Black, Brown, or White, I was taught to remain silent. It has become clear to me that the left political arena has committed crimes against humanity in every form imaginable against the American people.

It has become clear that still many men, while proudly speaking for America, remain a hurtful obstacle to women. As the founding member of the Union of Saints, I counter all violent political members of our society who take aim at me. This is where we draw the line.

White Men and Women Have Been Vilified Too Much

White men and women have been vilified too much in our lifetimes, we have been targeted, disparaged, disappeared, taken flight, and assaulted. Whites have been put down and erased from the picture. For many of us, we have endured this racial abuse our whole lives and have never been able to have even so much as a voice on the matter.

This is not just our race. It is who we are, our heritage, our culture, our everything. For these reasons, the intolerable foreign religious and communist movements, and the evil Black, Brown, and Yellow movements that do nothing but target White people within our society, have reached the line. The line is drawn.

The movement should have never stopped being about shared humanity, yet clearly, the picture was lost and was replaced with something far more evil. A violent predator, a rapist, a crime war, a large global war, and now, it is shaping up to be World War 3. You are no friend to us and no friend to me.

You have become our modern enemy. This is the choice you have made. To violently assault me, an American, an American nation, all because of the seething hatred in your heart and your relentless need to change me.

I no longer enable these hateful, spiteful, revengeful cultural changes, for it is clear this was nothing more than modern terrorism, intimidation, coercion and enslavement of our culture, and modern warfare. I hope that more Americans join in and recognize their own value and why this has all been a grand assault. Yet another grand derangement, yet another genocidal movement which has targeted our personhood and culture, attempted to erase our identity and assimilate us and other natives into a harmful and evil foreign culture, this was just another evil foreign war on our people.

I stand proudly today as a White American woman, and I speak this message firmly on the record: **the line is drawn *against* their anti-American war on US.**
