

My Worries & Complaints Regarding Activism, Surveillance, and American Protections

1. Not All People Participate in Activism or Aggravated Causes Against the American People

It is important to recognize that not all individuals within any ethnic, religious, political, or national group participate in activism, extremism, harassment, or actions against the American people, and assumptions about entire populations are harmful and often inaccurate.

2. The Union of Saints Position

The Union of Saints does not support hate speech or hostility toward Jewish people or any other ethnic or religious group. We believe activism that punishes entire groups of people for who they were born to be is not aligned with the humanity centered movement we seek to create. Policies can be enforced that protect citizens, preserve national security, and address lawful concerns without targeting innocent people or encouraging hatred.

With that said, I am concerned by my personal experiences and observations regarding surveillance culture, political activism, online harassment, and self described “investigators” operating within political and activist spheres.

As someone with a paralegal background, I understand that professional investigation is a licensed and regulated field. Citizens generally do not have unlimited authority to monitor, track, surveil, or repeatedly target other citizens. Depending on the conduct involved, activities such as persistent monitoring, cyber stalking, harassment, intimidation, unauthorized recording, coordinated targeting, or reputational attacks cross legal boundaries.

This concern extends both offline and online. When individuals claim activist or investigative motives while engaging in repeated surveillance or harassment of private citizens, important legal and ethical questions surface. Defamation, false accusations, stalking behavior, cyber harassment, and coordinated intimidation can potentially create civil or criminal liability depending on the circumstances and applicable laws.

While activism and political expression are protected forms of speech in the United States, there are still legal boundaries regarding harassment, threats, intimidation, targeted stalking, unlawful surveillance, and coordinated harm campaigns. It is important not to confuse lawful free speech with conduct that may violate the rights and safety of others.

I am also concerned about the growing atmosphere of political voyeurism, revenge based activism, ideological targeting, and polarization occurring within modern political culture.

Americans should remain aware that foreign governments, political organizations, extremist movements, and influence campaigns may attempt to exploit division, racial conflict, or ideological instability for their own strategic interests.

At the same time, concerns about foreign influence or political manipulation should be addressed carefully, factually, and without assigning blame to entire ethnic or religious populations. Governments, political actors, activists, and individuals should all be distinguished from one another rather than grouped together through assumption or suspicion.

I believe Americans increasingly need stronger safeguards involving:

- privacy protections,
- anti stalking enforcement,
- cyber harassment protections,
- civil rights protections,
- national security awareness,
- and responsible political moderation.

I also believe racial polarization and extremist identity politics are deeply dangerous to social stability and can weaken the unity and long term security of the United States. Political moderation, careful reasoning, lawful conduct, and shared humanity are the way forward. In many ways, they may be among the safest paths for US during periods of national division and political instability.

Protecting Americans should mean protecting constitutional rights, personal safety, civil liberties, lawful expression, and humanity for all people while rejecting hatred, unlawful intimidation, political extremism, and blame.

Stay safe, and say no to politically motivated, unlawful, and nonconsensual spying, stalking, harassment, and surveillance. Protect civil liberties, personal privacy, lawful boundaries, and humanity for all people regardless of political belief, race, religion, or background.

Report any unwanted, threatening, unlawful, or nonconsensual activity immediately to law enforcement or the appropriate reporting agency. Protect your safety, document concerning behavior when appropriate, and seek lawful support.
