We are struggling in Tucson, Arizona with homelessness and homeless encampments.

Despite submitting reports through the City's homeless encampment reporting process, no meaningful action has been taken regarding our concerns. Instead, the ticket was closed.

The City of Tucson operates with a General Fund budget of more than \$780 million, yet this issue is widely ignored.
