

Excessive Whiteness

In contemporary ideological discussions, the most explicit objective appears to be the “**decrease of whites**” and the corresponding **increase of “blackness.”**

This is not a minor or merely symbolic aim, but a robust social objective within certain activist movements. Interestingly, it is sometimes supported by whites themselves, often without a full awareness of the implications behind the language of “decreasing.”

When examined more carefully, the concept of “**decreasing**” a racial population raises serious ethical and historical concerns. Throughout history, rhetoric centered on reducing or eliminating a particular group has frequently preceded grave injustices.

For this reason, framing demographic change through the language of intentional reduction is alarming. To many observers, including US, it evokes the specter of a severe crisis, the very real and historically recognized threat of genocide.

The issue becomes less about **supporting opportunity for all**, and more about the “**taking**” of seats, the displacement of one group rather than the expansion of access.

More troubling, however, are the concerns of **political coordination and systemic sabotage** occurring across institutions throughout the country.

US is deeply concerned about the very real threat of White Genocide which is **actively witnessed today.**
