

## **Full Collaboration, Natural Process, and Synergy with Government, Investigative Agencies, and Public Support**

When I began these case studies, I worked very hard to get to the bottom of what I was experiencing. I documented my observations, held them as my truth, and gathered enough research to support as much of the experience as I could with available data. The issues I was encountering were too significant to ignore, and I knew something was wrong.

Of course, I was gaslit. As a result, I experienced blame, guilt, and further victimization by members of society who would have preferred to ignore the situation and continue with daily life. I was not impressed because I knew I was being truthful about what I had experienced, how significant the experience was, and why it should not be dismissed. I was a witness. The question was, what was I witnessing?

In the simplest terms, my conclusion was that I was witnessing organized crime targeting the American people, historic levels of unlawful migration, and forms of Fourth Generation Warfare. Over time, I found that many of the issues we discussed through the Union of Saints were also being examined by investigative agencies and government entities. Like finally receiving a diagnosis after a long illness, we arrived at a fuller understanding of the experience. It was not isolated. My experience was only one part of a much larger picture. It reflected the evolution of organized crime into a national security epidemic.

My recommendation today is a whole of government approach that includes cooperation among federal, state, and local agencies, stronger public awareness, and improved alert systems for Americans. I also believe the United States should continue evaluating whether existing legal authorities are sufficient to address threats associated with organized crime, foreign influence operations, and other forms of modern warfare. I feel that the American people have a right to stand their ground against modern forms of warfare, even when they occur on U.S. soil, which is why I feel that wartime powers are appropriate in Fourth Generation Warfare.

I strongly disagree with many actions and positions taken by certain judges, activist organizations, and political advocates on the left, and I believe their activism has extended beyond traditional political advocacy into forms of strategic Cold War. The deliberate deception of the public should never be accepted. Too many people have been led to believe that everything is normal and fine when significant public safety and national security concerns have yet to be addressed.

Those serving on the front lines, including members of the military, law enforcement, border security, emergency responders, and investigative agencies, continue to bear substantial risks in responding to organized crime and other threats. These are serious issues that deserve our full attention, public cooperation, and responsible policies that fully address these concerns.

Looking back over everything we have covered through the Union of Saints, our conclusion is that our experience reflects a combination of Fourth Generation Warfare, Cold War style

strategic competition, foreign influence and infiltration, organized crime, and cultural and political pressures that severely affect American communities.

We now recognize that this is not a game. It was never an isolated experience. The diagnosis is war, and lives are at risk. Wars are won when the opposition is complacent, fails to cooperate, and neglects to defend its people. Americans can lose everything through bad actors and bad policy.

We have done the work. Others have done the work. Together, we have reached our findings. We now have a comprehensive understanding of the experience before us, and our discovery has brought us to the truth. We are in the middle of a war. Let us first acknowledge this reality and then move forward, united as one great team, with the purpose of protecting our people, our communities, and our future.

Thank you to all those who have served, investigated, documented, and contributed to these understandings. Every effort to better understand the challenges before us strengthens our ability to respond responsibly and protect our communities. Our work continues.
