Imagine a culture that gives undocumented immigrants priority over hardworking Americans?

Foreign nationals are not domestic minority groups. They are entering American culture from separate nations. This distinction is not only imperative for Americans, it is a matter of political survival, especially during times of war, and it must be clearly recognized in law, policy, and political representation.

Despite common assumptions, White Americans are not one single race or culture. They represent a blending of many minority European ethnic cultures, including Irish, French, German, Acadian, and others. White populations are also a minority globally and continue to decline as a percentage of the world population. I often discuss Acadians because the Acadian population within America is itself a minority community.

White crime data categories may not accurately represent the White population as previously understood, because some reporting systems classify individuals from other populations within the "White" category. For this reason, I recommend that crime data be reported using more clearly defined population categories and that other populations be removed from White crime data classifications when those classifications distort public understanding.

With the sad and disturbing reality that rape culture, slavery culture, and extreme forms of cold war have targeted Americans on a grand scale, I recommend that foreign crime data be more clearly defined, including first and second generation data, in order to better understand foreign influence, organized crime patterns, and potential national security threats.

I also support reviewing, or closing, the use of the term "minority" in government policies and reporting to ensure that no demographic group, including American ethnic groups, are unfairly targeted, disadvantaged, especially by foreign aliens, or treated unequally under the law.

To promote peace and reduce racial conflict within the United States, political PACs and activist organizations should be held accountable when they engage in unlawful discrimination or target individuals or groups on the basis of race. Where such organizations violate applicable laws or constitutional protections, appropriate legal action should be taken.

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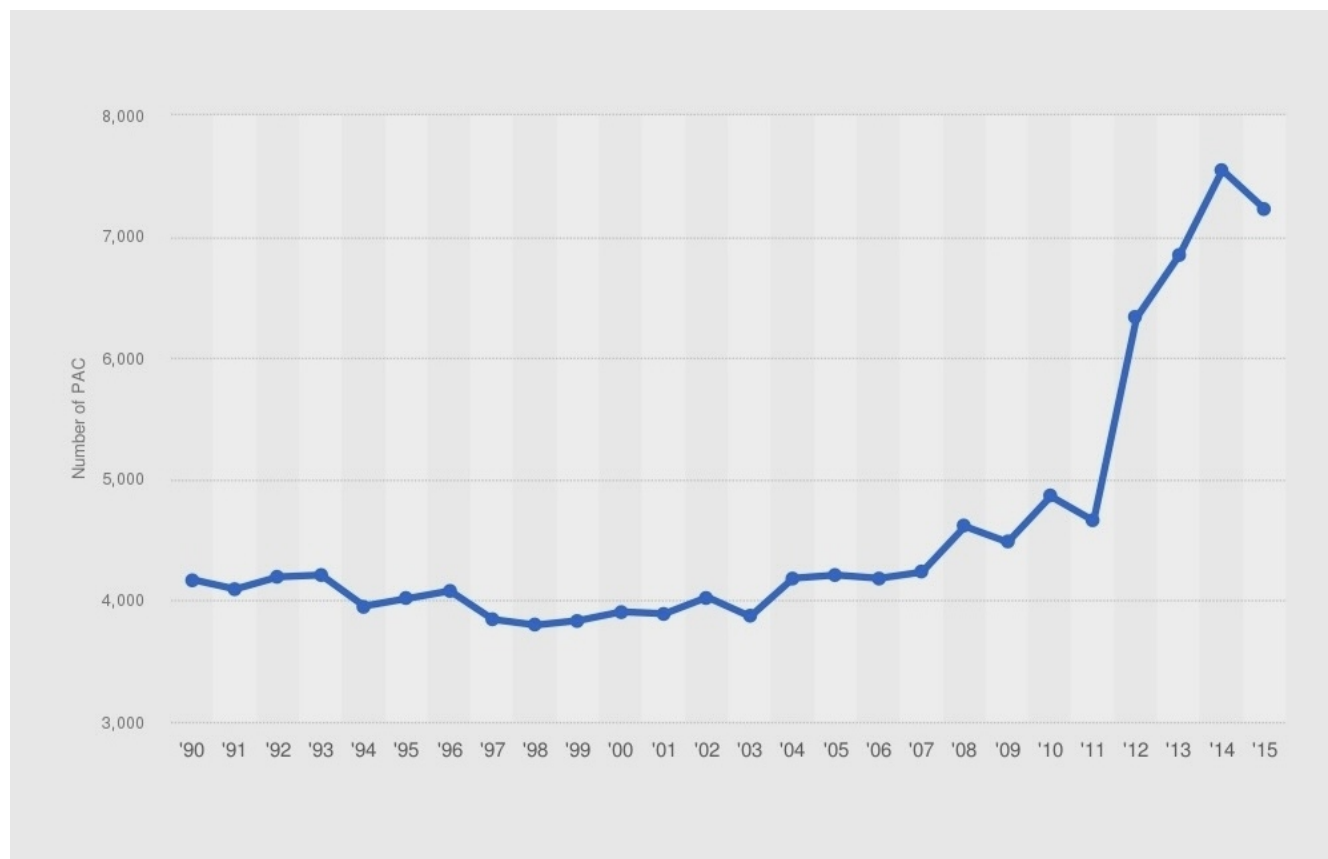
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
