

Civil War Creationism: Immigrant Mobilizations Against the Native American People

Mass instrumental migration has historically been used as a form of warfare and, when joined with suppression movements, poses a genocidal risk to Native people, their culture, heritage, and history. In our findings, it is a crime against humanity to forcibly assimilate foreign cultures onto native ones. Already, foreign language systems and cultural influences are displacing Native languages and traditions. Paired with terrorism, slavery, and exploitation, these developments are constituting an **American genocide movement**.

Our primary concerns are that non-documented immigrants have committed serious crimes, including the killing and rape of women and children, that they have engaged in forms of coercion that have contributed to a loss of freedoms and political slavery, and that they have participated in acts of violence so severe that they amount to **acts of war** against the American people.
