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It isn't just Seattle (as many of us know too well); it's all over the USA. These are modern-day ghettos, comparable to World War II. That's not the only thing occurring. It's a genocide; it's a Holocaust. Let it be the name. Call it a modern mass cost, call it modern war, it is happening. We have to first acknowledge it, give it a name, and recognize that it is solvable. It's just a matter of the energy from the American people who care. Call the guard in.

The boards are full of left activists, full of ideology and not enough reality; immigrants, particularly from China; the Jewish political Bund; and the Hispanic Federation. Response:



Seattle is not failing by accident. It is failing by design. While shootings go unanswered and public libraries are surrendered to disorder, the city's leadership has chosen to distribute drug-use supplies under the dishonest label of "harm reduction." Those supplies end up in parks, playgrounds, and outside public buildings. The government creates the filth, refuses to clean it, and then calls the result compassion.

The most revealing scandal is not the needles. It is the investigation. A volunteer cleanup group that collected more than 25 syringes, syringe parts, and roughly 100 pieces of drug residue foil in about 30 minutes is now reportedly facing a state investigation into its safety procedures. The same government that hands out drug paraphernalia without accountability is demanding paperwork from citizens who pick it up. That is not governance. That is punishment for refusing to accept decline.

Public libraries, parks, and playgrounds have become sacrifice zones. Parents inspect the ground before letting children play. Seniors avoid spaces built for everyone. Encampments spread without sanitation, and ordinary residents are told that enforcing basic public order is somehow cruel. This is what extreme left-wing rule produces: public spaces abandoned, lawlessness normalized, and civic responsibility treated as a threat.

The mayor must go. The policies must be reversed. Seattle has the wealth, talent, and resources to be one of the best-run cities in the nation. What it lacks is leadership willing to value order, safety, and the dignity of taxpayers over ideological fantasy. The full report exposes the uncomfortable truth: the people cleaning up Seattle are being targeted, while the people destroying it are being protected. That is not progress. It is a betrayal.

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
