This video shows how they classify the Latino population as White during arrests.

This can confuse the public because the “crime data” may be misleading.

I feel that racial classifications should be distinguished far more clearly than they currently are, including place of birth, parents' place of birth, home of record, gender, religion or ideology, and where the crime was committed.

White does not necessarily mean “White,” Irish, Swedish, French or Italian for example.

Races often classified within “White” category:

65.5% of all persons arrested were classified as White, but this represents **the entire** FBI White category—not specifically European-origin White people. This classification does not specify Native White Americans.

Acadians for example:

“What percentage of all U.S. arrests would likely involve people of Acadian ancestry?”

I'd expect **well below 1%**, probably on the order of **0.2–0.5% of arrests** *if their arrest rate were roughly comparable to the national average.*” – ChatGPT
