

The Black & Hispanic Hostiles

These are not “American”-natured citizens, but rather function like race gangs. They are very racist toward Whites, particularly White women. Very rude, very domineering, and very racist. There is no comfort in interactions, and the experience is almost always about superiority or, as we have been calling it, “supremacy.”

Much like the “hostiles” within Tucson South, these individuals and packs are throughout the South and Southwest, essentially changing the vibe of these regions to be more closed, withdrawn, and unfriendly. People grow guarded. I have noticed that I myself am now afraid to interact with certain groups, though I always try my best to give everyone a fair chance. I also trust my intuition.

A great portion of these groups are coming from Mexico. I do feel that many of these individuals are a part of the movement that is attempting to “reclaim” the southern border as Mexican. Males can also behave this way, becoming territorial. For example, one behavior is to “take up” the street and appear larger and more intimidating.

Whatever these behaviors are, they often target Whites, are racist, and are un-American. They create an overall atmosphere of hostility rather than peaceful enjoyment. I do feel that Americans should call this behavior out in political spheres and ensure that civil rights experts in the field are acknowledging abuses where they occur, rather than promoting a zero-sum experience in which White Americans are constantly vilified while every other race is viewed as the groups experiencing racism and discrimination, this is the bias and fallacy of our times.

Blame-shifting politics pose a real danger, especially amid the crime succession concerns within some Black and Hispanic communities. I write this in order to isolate these experiences. Speaking as a White American, I would much prefer that the culture did not experience such extreme changes and that the American spirit of freedom and equality is truly embraced, not a *culture* of constant race conflict and anti-White hate.
