

Black and Hispanic KKK

On the road!

1. Targeting and Organization

Much like the White KKK targeted White people as well, the Black and Hispanic KKK also targets Black and Hispanic people. This is why the experience is confusing. Proximity, location, as well as numbers, all play a role. They are operating like an “organized” gang, but their affiliation is a “wavelength,” and is often associated with Black or Hispanic race.

2. Areas of Concern

Places where there has been high forced cultural assimilation via Biden era immigrant and refugee replacement, a high rate of crime, including violent crime, shootings, and looting: Blizzard Boots!

3. Cultural Experience

It’s not a minor experience. It is cultural, like “open air drug markets.” These experiences are “open air White and vulnerable victim targeting markets.”

Columbus, Ohio, unfortunately, they are hanging out in gangs and tipping one another on who to target, and it is clear as day, like witnessing a Black and Hispanic KKK. However, the experience is “diverse” and “multicultural,” including “trans.”

Microaggressions are abundant. Don’t look in the wrong direction. Lock your doors. You can see them tipping each other when driving through. They will walk around your vehicle and even park next to you to “sense” you. Very strange experience.

Definitely seeing undocumented immigrants, and they are either doing the “shadow stare down,” or are very avoidant, or very hateful and looking for trouble. Not the best experience overall. Also, highly territorial.

One male was driving around blasting Hispanic music as loud as he could and then circling back. This is considered a form of psychological warfare. It isn’t just about music; it is about “territory.”

The same is happening within Muslim groups who play loud prayer on the speaker. The idea is to take over the “airways,” and has historically been used as a form of territorial warfare. Also noted was aggressive driving.

Overall Experience

Very sad and challenging. It truly alters the cultural wavelength. It isn't a subtle experience either. It has become a "cultural norm" and "trend."

The general experience was that of a "looter's paradise," strength in numbers. I was only in town for a brief amount of time and instantly felt the experience as soon as I turned and was waiting at a stoplight. There, the tipping began, and the "subtle approaching" began.

I am sure that if I stayed in town, they would have had more time to consider whether to target me. I noticed both Black and Hispanic males stalking my vehicle. I do have veteran plates. I can tell that the general wavelength within this community is hateful toward veterans. It feels "ghettoized," there is drug trafficking and homelessness.

Data and Demographics

The data supports my experience. What was interesting was that it was like I was witnessing the data in real time. Columbus, Ohio.

I feel that, unfortunately, because of the efforts of activists for so long and because of social norms, these types of experiences have mostly gone unchecked and therefore have been allowed to thrive.

People have been more protective in recent years of those same groups that hurt others than they have been of the victims they hurt. I feel that if there was a role reversal and it was not Black or Hispanic individuals, but rather Whites, it would be far more clear and would be reminiscent of an experience from earlier U.S. times when Whites had formed gangs and targeted Black culture.

Today, however, the opposite is true. White innocent victims are being targeted on the street by Black and Hispanic gangs.

There were also some Asian individuals I noticed who seemed to be "fearful" of the veteran plates I have, which I found odd. I think this is the general "culture" that has unfortunately been created due to activism on the left side.

However, when considering the bigger picture, one can understand why some may feel fear.

Columbus, Ohio

The other consideration is that Columbus, Ohio, was claimed as a partial "sanctuary city," in which the police were told not to work with ICE or federal agents. It was a part of a "refugee resettlement project," and the city was given over \$6 million to place refugees and immigrants within the city.

This has changed the demographics within the city, which is clearly unfair to local residents. Changing the natural demographics of a place is not a subtle political change. It is not okay to

alter a culture through mass population changes. Never has it been, and it still is not okay. A complete alteration of the culture of a place by foreigners?

While we consider humanity, today the locals are being targeted now, not in minor ways. It has become a cultural norm to target others in acts of street violence. This experience is out in the open and very noticeable. It is also everywhere.

When I was there briefly, there were at least five shootings around the city. Poverty is no excuse. Some of the Hispanic men who had been stalking my vehicle were driving a Mercedes.

We are having a clear cultural issue where natural and local demographics have now become targets for newcomers. This is not a normal American cultural experience. It is the result of unchecked violence and street war.

Furthermore, looting has also been excused. In Columbus, SNAP benefits had been removed, and the entitlement is so severe among these groups that they felt it was justified to loot, which is essentially armed robbery on steroids. No longer is it one individual robbing; it is now a stampede of violent individuals who absolutely destroy entire businesses, particularly White owned businesses.

It then becomes race conflict or war.

Crime and Street Violence

When I was doing my research, I did read that there was a succession in crime, Black and Hispanic, and I did not know what had happened or where it was happening at the time. I was still processing this information.

However, after traveling around the United States from coast to coast, I can say that this experience is clearly true, and it is to an extreme that is difficult to grasp.

Imagine the KKK. Yet, it isn't a small group; it is an entire culture. This is how severe the issue has become.

So, what gives? Something has to give, and it assuredly isn't left politics, "crimes of necessity," and pretending that White people are not being targeted while someone's grandmother is being violently assaulted just for being White.

A female CEO who worked her entire life to get to where she was, a huge success for women, not just White women, was stabbed to death. Stabbed on the bus. Lit on fire. Shot. Beaten with a hammer.

No, this is not the KKK, not even close. It is a mainstream violent street war brought to us by individuals engaging in violence and guerrilla style attacks targeting innocent and vulnerable victims in cold blood.

It is far worse!
