The organization is the [American Immigration Council](#) (formerly often called the American Immigration Council), and it has been a major supporter of **state Offices of New Americans (ONAs)** through its policy work and by co-leading the **ONA State Network** with World Education Services. The network assists states [state politicians] that want to establish their own Offices of New Americans. ([American Immigration Council](#))

Those offices have generally been established by:

- State legislatures,
- Governors through executive orders,
- Or state agencies.

For example:

- New Jersey created its Office of New Americans by executive order in **2019**.
- Colorado studied and developed its office through state legislation.
- New Mexico established its Office of New Americans within its Department of Workforce Solutions. ([cdle.colorado.gov](#))

The American Immigration Council's role has been to provide research, technical assistance, and convene officials through the ONA State Network, rather than being the legal authority that creates those offices. ([American Immigration Council](#))

According to the [American Immigration Council](#), about **20 states** have either an Office of New Americans or a comparable statewide office or **senior official** focused on immigrant integration. ([American Immigration Council](#))

According to the American Immigration Council, the expansion of these offices accelerated beginning around **2019**, when it and **World Education Services** began coordinating the Office of New Americans State Network, which provides technical assistance and policy support to participating states. 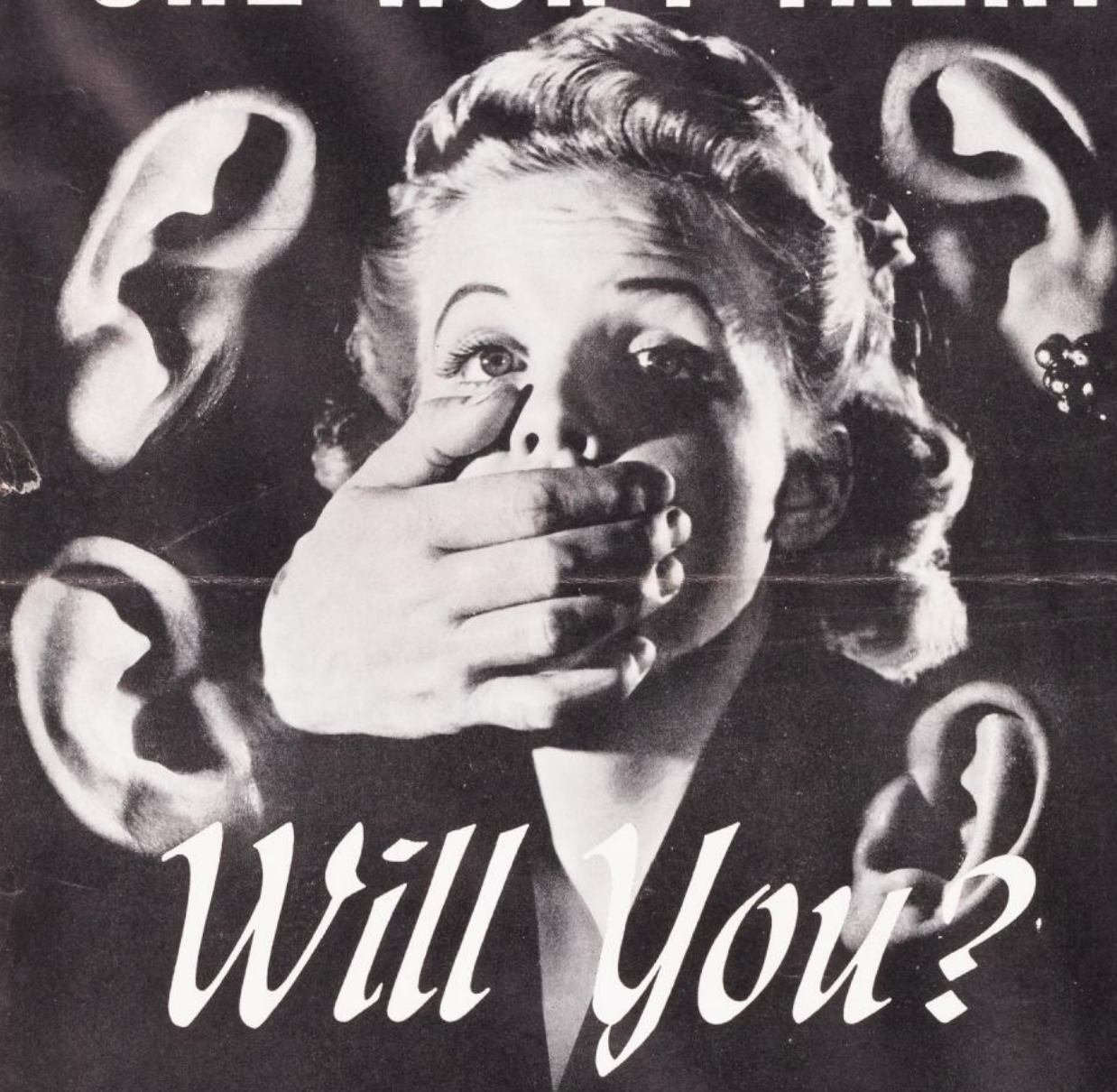
