

A Potential New Paradigm - AFP & REI

This model would remove global competition from American institutions by separating foreign participation from domestic priorities, giving Americans choice and first priority. It would serve as the opposite of DEI through AFP and REI: America First Priority and Remigration Enforcement Initiatives.

The model would restore American opportunity within universities and other institutions where Americans have been placed last and forced into global competition, diminishing their spirit, energy, and ability to succeed without forced global assimilation. Universities could continue educating international students while ensuring that American students retain priority, opportunity, and protection from coercive assimilation.

Certain sensitive fields of education and public authority, particularly those connected to government, national security, and the administration of American law, should have citizenship-based restrictions where justified. Judgeships and other public offices already subject to citizenship requirements should remain reserved for Americans. Restrictions involving legal education and professional licensing would also be proposed to ensure that sensitive positions involving American law, courts, public policy, and governmental authority remain reserved for American citizens.

These measures would be intended to protect Americans from foreign adversaries, political subversion, modern forms of conflict such as fourth-generation warfare, geopolitical competition, and foreign influence within American institutions. This would be more than an economic or educational policy. It would be presented as a national-safety measure designed to restore American opportunity, sovereignty, and institutional security.
