

## Policy Statement, Organizations Such As ACLU

Radical, violent, and extreme activist organizations and hate campaigns have modeled their "free speech" platforms after the KKK because of organizations such as the ACLU, which forcefully defended the KKK on its behalf, effectively leveraging the organization and others like it.

### Policy Statement

Maine should pass laws that permanently and irrevocably protect the State from organizations whose advocacy and legislative efforts perpetuate false propaganda, Cold War style political tactics, religious zygotic warfare, and actions that undermine public safety during periods of human trafficking, organized crime, unlawful migration, modern ghettoizing, and prolonged political neglect of local communities.

The invasion is here. No more protections for violent criminals who are in the country unlawfully and who pose a risk to public safety and national security. A few years ago, when smugglers were crossing the border, this was not a debate. Organizations such as the ACLU, which have promoted extremist policies, including campaigns to abolish ICE, have weakened homeland security efforts, immigration enforcement, and public safety. Their supporters promote harming our military and public servants. They target DHS. Their radical policies remove American protections, akin to ethnic cleansing, allowing violent predators to roam free, killing our people and our homeland.

Enough is enough. Harmful activism has consequences. Mainers, it's time to come together and protect Maine.

It's easy to sit in an office and be ungrateful, but our military puts their lives on the line every day to keep our people safe from harm. Their sacrifice does not go unnoticed. Every 1.9 days, a public servant dies fighting for our country. These selfless individuals paid the ultimate sacrifice. They are heroes. Not a thank you from organizations like the ACLU and their supporting regime of foreign coalitions, some already named as terrorists.

Maine, this is a mercy plea for dying Americans.

End the ACLU era indefinitely. Let them know they are not welcome here, and neither is the realm of smugglers, traffickers, terrorists, foreign flag waiving warfarists, and violent criminals they are adamantly protecting.
