Still:

Americans are frequently told they must adapt to foreign cultures, welcome foreign flags and customs, and remain silent when hostility is directed toward White Americans. Immigration and cultural exchange should never require Americans to surrender their identity, tolerate racial hostility, or accept unequal standards. Every racial and cultural group deserves equal protection, mutual respect, and the freedom to preserve its heritage.

The unrest associated with the 2020 George Floyd and Black Lives Matter demonstrations also caused extensive harm. Rioting, arson, looting and vandalism produced more than \$2 billion in insured losses, while total economic damage was substantially higher after uninsured losses, destroyed businesses, lost employment, emergency costs and rebuilding were considered. Minneapolis and Saint Paul alone sustained approximately \$500 million in damage, and many locally and minority-owned businesses were harmed.

More than 2,000 police officers were injured during the unrest examined by the Major Cities Chiefs Association. A 2025 academic study identified 31 homicides associated with the 2020 protests and riots, although responsibility varied and not every killing was committed by a BLM supporter. Even in 2025, nearly half of the 48 Minneapolis properties classified as destroyed reportedly remained vacant lots.

Most demonstrations did not produce documented property damage, and not everyone who committed violence, arson or theft belonged to an official BLM organization. Nevertheless, the violent unrest occurring under and around the BLM banner caused billions of dollars in losses, deaths, injuries, destroyed livelihoods and lasting damage to American communities. Peaceful advocacy is protected, but violence, racial hostility, intimidation, destruction and unequal treatment should never be excused because they are associated with a favored political movement.
