1. Classic Symbols of Danger

- **Broken or jagged arrow** – represents aggression, attack, or incoming harm.
 - **Lightning bolt** – sudden, destructive force; also symbolizes power and threat.
 - **Flaming sword** – a direct symbol of confrontation and defense; spiritual/moral undertones.
 - **Skull or horned figure** – danger, death, or malevolent intent.

2. Protective vs. Threat Symbols

These show that attacks exist but also suggest vigilance:

- **Shield with cracks or spikes** – attackers hitting boundaries; represents threat while implying defense.
 - **Circle with a slash (⊘)** – universal “no” or opposition; marks the presence of an adversary.
 - **Dark clouds or storm** – chaos, trouble, or malevolent forces approaching.

3. Spiritual or Metaphorical Symbols

- **Shadow figure** – unknown, hidden, or deceptive force.
 - **Snake or serpent** – deception, betrayal, or manipulative attack.
 - **Black wolf or raven** – predator, stealth, or cunning enemy.
 - **Chains or shackles** – oppression or harmful control.

4. Hybrid/Abstract Ideas

- **Fractured circle** – something meant to be whole is under attack.
- **Opposing arrows** – forces coming against each other; confrontation.
- **Jagged spiral** – harmful influence spreading outward, unseen at first.

At the Union of Saints, we use the symbol of the “Crooked Letter Eye” to represent those who seek to harm us.

OS~I~V~RAM embodies this concept:

- **Circle of Death** – the inevitable consequences of unchecked malice.
- **Evil Snake** – deception and hidden threats.
- **Crooked or Twisted Eye** – distorted perception, manipulative intent.
- **Underworld or Otherworldly** – forces beyond ordinary awareness.
- **Ram** – forceful intrusion, disregard for boundaries, and the pushing of limits.

OZIRAH guides us through this complex world, helping us recognize the unaware, the unenlightened, and those who would exploit or harm. She offers symbology that harmonizes our human nature with our higher self—balancing our loving, compassionate side with our protective, discerning side.

We are kind, ethical, and forgiving. Yet, we are human, divine with god, but not god, living in a world often shadowed by violence and harm. To protect ourselves and our families is not sin, it is our right. At the same time, we must remember that protection does not justify unnecessary harm to others. Boundaries and discernment are acts of wisdom, not malice.
