

Bipartisan Concerns, Domestic Warfare, Foreign Infiltration, Fraud

The empty rhetoric from the far left does nothing but fuel more hatred and chaos. Chanting on social media, calling fellow Americans “colonizers,” or aiming bullets at police does not solve anything—it only adds fuel to the fire of stupidity.

We must get with reality. America just experienced the worst invasion in all of human history. Our government, whatever its party lines, is working around the clock in the face of violence and upheaval to keep Americans safe. Much of this violence is driven by those who are not even from here—committing atrocities against innocent civilians.

Veterans who love this country see it clearly. Even when we stand as individuals, we are bound as brothers and sisters in spirit. When the hint of warfare arises, we march together. Protecting Americans is what we were born to do, and we will lay our lives on the line to ensure it. So, to those attacking our military: we see you, and we will hold you accountable. Karma is real—and it is already unfolding.

If you are here enjoying the freedoms of this country while taking Americans for granted, pushing us down, or seeking to harm us—you will be found out, and something will be done about it.
