Necklace

With a little patience, a touch of sparkle, and a glassy coat of magic, the gumballs would never lose their shine. Instead of being chewed away, they would twinkle forever as a necklace fit for candy royalty. 🍖 🁑



What You'll Need

- A handful of real gumballs (as colorful as you like)
- Clear-drying craft sealer (like Mod Podge)
- **Epoxy resin** (two-part, clear and shiny)
- Toothpicks or skewers (like candy wands)
- A foam block (to hold the drying treasures)
- A drill or bead reamer (for stringing necklace together)
- A length of necklace cord or ribbon (your choice will be just lovely!)

🧦 The Magical Steps

1. Seal the Sweetness \Rightarrow

Brush each gumball with a thin coat of clear sealer. This locks away the sugar inside so it won't fade, shrink, or crack. Let them dry completely—like raindrops turning to glass.

2. Carve the Path 🌟

If you'd like to string your necklace, drill a tiny hole straight through the gumball before the magic shell is added. (If you'd rather glue on a little bail later, that works too!)

3. Dip in Magic Glass 💫

Mix your epoxy resin carefully, like a potion. With your gumball held on a toothpick, dip or brush on a thin layer of resin. Watch as it turns shiny and bright, like crystal candy.

4. Rest and Dream

Place the gumball upright in the foam block and let it cure. One layer is lovely, but two or three coats make it strong, like armor for treasure.

5. String the Jewels 🐙

When all is dry and sparkling, string your gumballs onto ribbon or cord. Knot the ends, tie a bow, or fasten with jewelry findings.

A Note from the Candy Kingdom

Your bubblegum necklace is no longer for chewing—it's a forever jewel! Treat it gently, keep it away from too much heat or water, and it will always remind you of the day you turned candy into treasure.
