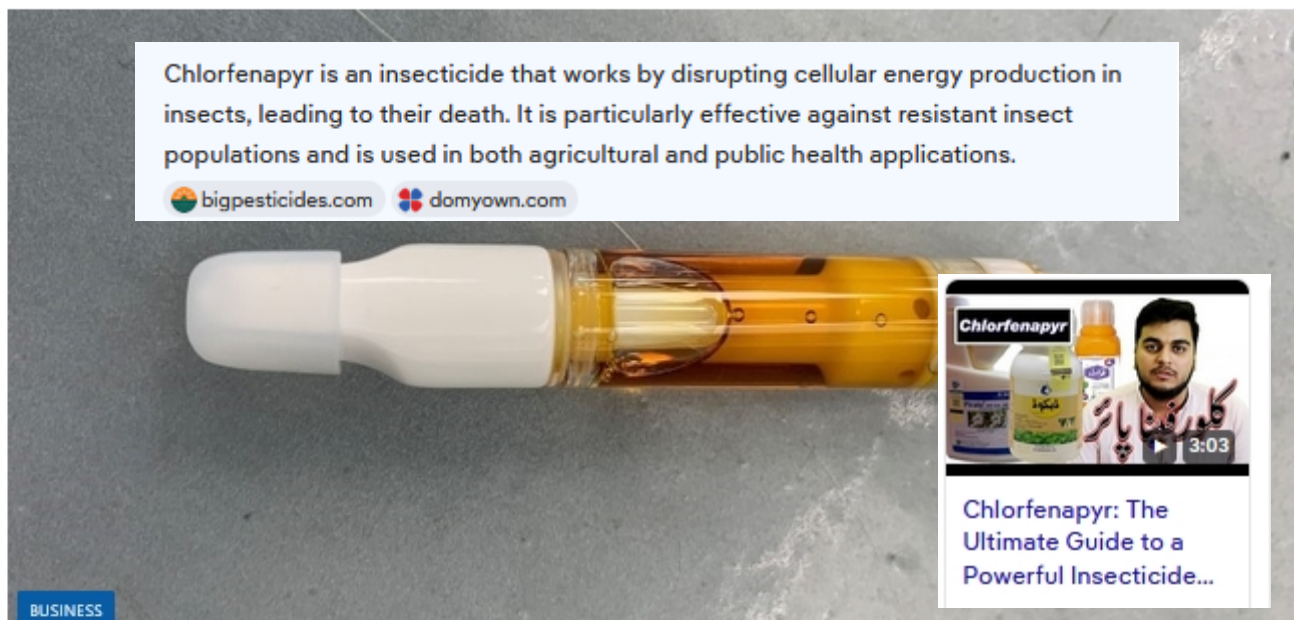

Maine Cannabis Bureau Issues Recall Over Pesticide Linked to Illicit Chinese Grows: Chlorfenapyr

Unsafe levels of chlorfenapyr present in cannabis vape cartridges have led the Maine Office of Cannabis Policy to issue a recall for products marketed by Yani Maine. "This recall is a result of an investigation into a consumer complaint about an adverse health reaction," the cannabis regulator said in a statement Monday. "OCP's investigation included testing on the batch of vape cartridges alleged to have caused the adverse reaction," OCP said. "The products are being recalled due to those testing results showing unsafe levels of the pesticide chlorfenapyr." Acts in Furtherance of the Marihuana Conspiracy

9. On various dates from in or about January 2020 through the present, the defendants and others known and unknown to the Grand Jury committed and caused to be committed the following acts, among others, in furtherance of the marihuana conspiracy:

10. On or about November 12, 2023, (2) WU sent (1) CHEN an article entitled, "Triad Weed: How Chinese Marijuana Grows Took Over Rural Maine" and other, similar articles concerning Chinese marihuana grow operations in Oklahoma by WeChat message.

11. Beginning on or about March 13, 2024, and continuing until on or about March 17, 2024, (1) CHEN exchanged a series of WeChat messages with (3) LI where (1) CHEN directed (3) LI to travel to an address in Albany, New York to deliver \$35,000. (1) CHEN cautioned (3) LI, "Pay the money immediately," "Don't linger," and "So dangerous."

12. On or about January 11, 2024, (1) CHEN paid for one alien to be smuggled across the United States – Mexico border.



Farmington attorney Paul Mills, the brother of Maine Gov. Janet Mills (D), first popped into The Maine Wire's multi-year investigation into Chinese drug cartels operating in rural Maine in March 2024, when we uncovered real estate records showing Mills' involvement in a bizarre real estate deal that transferred an illicit cannabis grow to a Chinese national living in Guangdong Province, China. Since the first story broke, Mills has continued to facilitate real estate deals involving out-of-state cannabis entrepreneurs, including a cluster of Chinese growers who've opened up shop within miles of his home in New Sharon. As his sister vies for a position in the U.S. Senate, county property records and state cannabis records show no sign that the eager real estate attorney is moderating his involvement in the seedy world of cannabis to protect his older sibling from accusations that she's soft on organized crime — and perhaps a little too comfortable with transnational criminal organizations the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and the Justice Department have linked to human trafficking, fentanyl trafficking, and the Chinese Communist Party.



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
